Primary Schools are now into their fourth year of receiving the Government P.E. and School Sport Funding. St Mary's will receive £8910 in funding for this academic year, which is ring fenced to be used to improve the provision of P.E. and Sport in School. Below is a table of proposed spending:

To pay supply costs and course fees for P.E. subject leader	£1000	To provide continual CPD for P.E. subject leader – particular focus on Curriculum development and assessment of P.E. aiming to use links with St Joseph's Harrogate to implement the Real PE scheme of work.
To purchase awards for Sports Awards Evening and resources for Intra-School Competitions	£600	To host an end of year celebration of achievements in Curriculum P.E. and HSSP competitions.
To pay for coaches to support the delivery of Curriculum P.E and Extra-Curricular activities	£500	To provide additional support for teachers in particular areas of the P.E. Curriculum. To provide a wider range of sporting opportunities for all children through Extra-Curricular activities.
To hire of Knaresborough Swimming Pool and lifeguards for competition Level 1 intra school competitions – Year 3/4 and Year 5/6	£500	To host two intra-school Level 1 swimming competitions allowing all KS2 children to have the opportunity to compete.
